- The only amplification you have is the omni-microphone.
- Groups can be any size, but remember you only get the omni-mike, so be sure to practise the dancing that involves multiple people/instruments on a single microphone.

- You and any performing members of your group will receive a complimentary weekend pass to the festival.
- You will have backstage access throughout the festival, including our wonderful Cantina.
- The practise warm-up area is a private shack tent that will be shown to you upon arrival.
